This is a reminder that the current transitional period for the IDAS development application forms is due to expire on Friday 29 February 2008. The immediately superseded IDAS application forms, in the previous format, should no longer be used after this date.

It is expected that amended Smart eDA forms will be available from the IPA website from Monday 3 March 2008. The amendments have been made in response to feedback received from users about the application forms.
