## Neighbourhood and Community Centre Strategic Repositioning Committee

3 November 2021

The Queensland Neighbourhood and Community Centre (NCC) Strategic Repositioning Committee held their fourth meeting on Wednesday, 3 November 2021.

This meeting was primarily focussed on progressing content for the strategic framework for NCCs. This provided Committee members with an opportunity to comment on the latest version of a working paper, developed by the sub-group with support from Professor Tim Reddel of the University of Queensland.

The Committee also considered and discussed the ways in which other organisations support vulnerable people to navigate the service system. The Committee received a presentation from Services Australia, who presented an overview of their Vulnerability Strategy and discussed the impacts of COVID-19 on the people they support.

The Committee also prepared for an in-person workshop to be held on 11 November 2021 and considered items for the agenda for the full-day session.
