Neighbourhood and Community Centre Strategic Repositioning Committee

24 August 2022

The Queensland Neighbourhood and Community Centre (NCC) Strategic Repositioning Committee held its eleventh meeting on Wednesday 24 August 2022.

The Committee meeting began with an update from the Department about the NCC Strategic Repositioning Project progress including the revision of the Terms of Reference. The Department also noted progress on the proposed methods of engagement with the broader sector.

The Committee then revisited discussions around the strategic framework, noting that work on the performance and reporting framework had been progressing via workshops with a sub-group of the Committee. Members discussed building the data and evidence story and general principles, indicators, and measures of performance. Committee members also raised discussions on the broader ecosystem in which the strategy frameworks would fit.

Committee members agreed that additional workshops to progress strategic framework documents would be held prior to the next formal meeting.
